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## **Scope and Content Note**

This series consists of subject and correspondence files produced by executive staff of the Division of Housing and Community Renewal (DHCR). The series also contains reports (1952-1966) related to housing, primarily in New York City.

The files of Avrum Hyman, Executive Assistant to the Commissioner, include staff assignments; long range planning submissions; material related to President Nixon's Task Force on Housing and Community Renewal; press releases; proposed legislation; correspondence including reference requests forwarded from the executive chamber for reply, correspondence to

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Commissioner James William Gaynor, and replies drafted by Hyman to many local government and state agency officials; and other administrative material.

Records of Henry Nussbaum, Director of the Finance and Audit Bureau, consist of applications for various proposed housing projects including Parkshore Housing Corporation; Mount Kisco Middle Income Housing Corporation; Hudsonview Plaza, Inc; and the Morris Park Housing Council.

Records from Lee Goodwin, Assistant Commissioner and Commissioner (1971-1973) include material related to the Housing Finance Agency; files concerning legislation sponsored by or affecting DHCR; files on New York City agencies; general correspondence and daily mail records; requests for housing from private citizens; press releases; and files on federal agencies and activities related to housing.
