In addition, the images show workers engaged in such activities as fishing, farming, and industry.

Among the industries documented by the records are steel and iron, rubber, aircraft, camera and film, optics, glass, electrical installation, printing and publishing, cement, sauerkraut, paint, carpet, wallpaper and color, oil, art metal, and musical instruments. The photographs cover the following geographic regions of New York State, as defined by the Division of Archives and History: Long Island, New York City, Upstate New York, Albany, Adirondacks, Finger Lakes, Buffalo, and Niagara Falls.
