Included are disciplinary letters; files on sealing and burning of notes; diaries of financial transactions; fund ledgers, daybooks, and blotters; certificates of securities; register's receipts of impressions; powers of attorney; transfer books; savings bank expense books; certificates of association of banks of deposit and discount; records of certificates of organization and authorization of private banks, bankers, brokers, and credit unions; journals; registers of receipt and disposal of notes; ledgers of notes in circulation; security registers; journals of bank notes, stocks, and bonds; and ledgers for general and miscellaneous accounts.
