The abstracts were compiled and submitted to the Comptroller in pursuance of an Act passed May 7, 1839, regarding compensation of Clerks of the Supreme Court. Both booklets were signed by William P. Hallett, Supreme Court Clerk, and were sworn before a Commissioner of Deeds. The statements give names of individuals and amounts.
