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## Administrative History

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This series was maintained by Francis E. Griffin, secretary-treasurer of the Council on Rural Education (CORE) and chief of the Bureau of Rural Administrative Services.

CORE was formed in 1943 by rural and educational organizations concerned with the quality of education available in rural areas of New York. It included representatives of agricultural groups; district, village, and city superintendents; secondary school principals; and the Education Department. Its purpose was to study the problems of rural education and make available its findings.

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## Scope and Content Note

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These files contain: correspondence with member organizations concerning programs and legislation promoted by CORE, and regarding CORE membership; minutes of meetings of CORE and its executive board; and annual treasurer's reports. They provide information on studies and publications of CORE, the development of legislation affecting rural education, and the general administration of CORE.
