State's Canal System). Such books were compilations of work done in the field while surveying, building or providing maintenance to the canal and its structures.

Material indexed dates approximately from 1833 to 1915. Many references are to the period of the second canal enlargement (so-called "9 Million Improvement") in 1896. There are also references to canal feeders and ancillary canals associated with the canal enlargement of 1835-1841.

The location of the bulk of the card file is unknown.
