Administrative History

Chapter 147 of the Laws of 1903, informally known as the Barge Canal Law, was an act passed by New York legislature making provision for issuing bonds for the improvement of the Erie, Oswego, and Champlain canals. This act allotted up to one hundred and one million dollars for these improvements.
