Administrative History

Chapter 147 of the Laws of 1903, informally known as the Barge Canal Law, was an act passed by New York legislature making provision for issuing bonds for the improvement of the Erie, Oswego and Champlain canals. This act alotted up to one hundred and one million dollars for these improvements.

Scope and Content Note

This series consists of a volume of monthly expenditures for the improvement of sections of the Champlain, Erie, and Oswego Canals as directed by Chapter 147, Laws of 1903. The volume shows the amount spent on salaries and wages; equipment; expenses; construction contracts; sundries; and total amounts. Most of the forms in the volume were never used.
