The reports were issued as a result of studies of various aspects of public employee pension and retirement systems in New York State, by which the commission made recommendations for improvements to those systems.

The commission reviewed features of existing major systems within New York and in other states, to assess strengths and inadequacies. The reports typically include extensive appendices, often with tables and charts, comparing requirements or detailing benefits or costs of various plans.
