Topics include archaeology, church histories, local history, school histories, historic buildings, churches and religion, museums, anniversary celebrations of events, historic markers and memorials,

Types of material include pamphlets, leaflets, souvenir programs, journals and articles published by historical societies, photographs (few) and other graphic works, guidebooks, scrapbooks, maps, tourism brochures, correspondence, typescripts, news clippings, postcards, biographies, and bibliographies. Items included in the series were typically created by state and local historical societies; county and municipal historians; private business companies; state, local, and federal governments; churches; and schools and universities. A few items in the series, such as local history source leaflets, were created by the Division of Archives and History.
