part, manufacturer of part, state contract number (Barge Canal contract number), state sheet number, and storage locations for the patterns at Dept. of Public Works facilities in Waterford and Syracuse.

The cards can be used in conjunction with series B1765, New York State Barge Canal System Shop Drawings, to identify specific patterns: state contract number and state sheet number correspond to individual shop drawings and pattern mark number can be used to identify the patterns on the shop drawings.
