This series consists of archival copies of the publicly accessible website of the Wadsworth Center for Laboratories and Research, which is part of the New York State Department of Health.

B2151-07: This accretion consists of a copy of the Wadsworth Center for Laboratories and Research website produced on December 25, 2006, shortly before Governor George E. Pataki (1995-2006) left office. It contains information about the center's mission and the work of its Division of Environmental Disease Prevention, Division of Genetic Disorders, Division of Infectious Disease, and Division of Molecular Medicine. It also includes information about staff research projects, the center's laboratory programs, undergraduate and graduate education and training programs, and seminars and workshops. Information about the center's role in screening newborn infants for genetic and other diseases and regulating medical and environmental laboratories located in New York State is also present.

Researchers should note that, owing to the limitations of Web archiving technology and the structure of the live site, the appearance of this copy differs substantially from that of the live site. A lengthy series of navigational links appears at the top of each page, and it may be necessary to scroll down in order to see page-specific content. It contains updated information about the center's mission and its divisions, news items (2009-2014) concerning staff accomplishments and upcoming events, and newer information about staff research projects and education and training programs.

B2151-20: This accretion consists of a copy of the Wadsworth Center for Laboratories and Research site produced on January 13, 2020. It contains updated information about the center and its public health, research, regulatory, educational, and grant funding programs and newer news items (2015-2019) concerning staff accomplishments and upcoming events.
