The remainders of the entries in the first volume are typically of guests attending convocations of the University of the State of New York. The volume also includes photographs from the convocations, one of which depicts Albert Einstein at the time he received an honorary degree

in 1936. The second smaller volume documents individuals and small groups of visitors to the Regents on miscellaneous occasions as well as to convocations.
