date of satisfaction (usually blank).

Alphabetic by first letter of last name of party against whom judgment was obtained, then chronological by date of filing the judgment record.

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satisfaction (usually blank). The transcripts were compiled every two weeks by the clerk of the Supreme Court of Judicature at Albany. They were made and their contents certified as to accuracy by the clerk of the court, pursuant to a law of 1798. The four unbound fascicles in this series cover the periods August-November 1808, May-August 1810, February-May 1811, and May-August 1811. These transcripts may be those sent by the Albany clerk to another office of the Supreme Court and returned to the new Court of Appeals in 1847.
