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## Overview of the Records

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<b>Repository:</b>	New York State Archives
<b>Summary:</b>	Registers contain lists of writs sealed and issued by the clerk of the Supreme Court of Judicature at New York City. Each entry in a register includes the date of issuance, names of plaintiff and defendant, and type of writ. County is mentioned if a writ was directed to a sheriff outside of New York City and County. Most of the entries are for writs of <i>capias ad respondendum</i> , <i>capias ad satisfaciendum</i> , and <i>fieri facias</i> , but many other types of writs are represented.

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## Arrangement

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Arrangement of entries in each volume is by attorney's surname (usually alphabetical by initial letter), then chronological by court term and date of issuance of writ.

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## Scope and Content Note

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Registers contain lists of writs sealed and issued by the clerk of the Supreme Court of Judicature at New York City. Each entry in a register includes the date of issuance, names of plaintiff and defendant, and type of writ. County is mentioned if a writ was directed to a sheriff outside of New York City and County. Most of the entries are for writs of *capias ad*

respondendum, capias ad satisfaciendum, and fieri facias, but many other types of writs are represented.
