Scope and Content Note

The meeting files consist of clerk's reports and voting sheets for 18 meetings dating from January 24 to June 26, 1989. Also included is a final report summarizing the action taken on all bills referred to the committee in 1989; copies of letters sent to committee members stating the

meeting dates at which they were marked absent; and log and status sheets giving bill number, sponsor, subject, committee action, senate bill number and sponsor, and notes.

The bill files typically include: a copy of the bill; memorandum in support of legislation (required by Assembly rules) giving purpose, summary, and justification for the bill; committee bill memorandum giving: bill number(s); sponsor(s); subject and purpose; summary of provisions; effective date; legislative history; arguments in support and opposition; and fiscal implications; and other legislative memoranda and (rarely) correspondence from interested parties requesting copies of the bill or offering an opinion.
