The series consists of subject files of Senator James Donovan, largely related to his chairmanship of the Senate Education Committee from 1977-1990. Records include correspondence, legislative bills, press releases, notes, agenda, reports, and press clippings.

Subjects include licensing and education of acupuncturists; promotion of education programs to enable welfare recipients to enter the workforce; local school boards; social services to youth; state financial assistance to local school districts; school construction and repair; health insurance payments for school districts; and New York City school governance (Marchi
